Friday Itinerary:

4:00pm (After School)	Call Time in Band Hall (8 th Graders at LVMS may ride bus #407 over to the high school if need be after school.) Meals will be provided by the Band Directors – Bush's Chicken
4:25pm	Dressed and Ready to go for Inspection/Load Busses
4:35pm	Load Busses/Depart for Comfort
6:45pm	Arrive at Comfort/Quick Unload
7:30pm	Kickoff! Go Vikings!
10:30pm	Approximate Game End/Load Up
12:30am	Approximate Return to LVHS*

*** We will have students call their rides for pick up as soon as we are about 30 minutes away. We ask that rides be ready to pick up their students immediately after we have unloaded our trailer.**

Uniform

We will be in the same uniform that we did for Homecoming. Please make sure that you have all uniform parts ready to go:

- Blue Band Shirt/Leadership may wear their Leadership shirts.
- Black Marching Shorts (under your marching pants)
- Black Marching Pants and Jackets
- Black calf-high or knee-high socks.

Meal Information/Snacks

The directors will be providing Bush's Chicken boxed meals for all of our students and chaperones for this week's game. Meals will be available when students arrive in the Band Hall for call time. Students may take a sealable water bottle with them on the bus, but no food will be permitted. **Absolutely no food or drinks may be shared between students at any time.**

Transportation

We will be taking district transportation to the game this week. We will be on two busses. Sign ups will be available at Thursday morning practice.

Alternative Transportation

We understand there may be parents/guardians that are hesitant about students traveling, so we are allowing students to be taken to and from the event by their parents/guardians if they wish to do so. Any student who wishes to do so will need to fill out the “Alternative Transportation Form” that is included in this document. The completed form must be turned in no later than Thursday morning’s band rehearsal. Students who elect to travel with their parents to the game must travel to and from the game.

Students who wish to travel home with their parents may do so, but an email must be submitted to the directors by noon on Friday of the game. You do NOT need to complete the attached form if you will be riding home with a parent – an email will suffice. All transportation requests must be submitted by Thursday evening.

Game Information

We will be the visitors for this game, therefore, we will be sitting on the visitor side of the stadium, but we will be in chairs on the track. Students will not be permitted to leave the designated band area in the stands for any reason, except with director permission.

Returning to LVHS from the Game

All students will call their rides when we are within 30 minutes of the high school. We ask that all rides be ready for pick up at that time. All students are required to assist with the unloading of the trailer before they are dismissed. The more help – the faster it goes!

I want to thank all of our band students for their continued dedication to our Covid-19 safety protocols and procedures. We have maneuvered through these strange times very well and I am proud of the flexibility and understanding our students have shown throughout the many changes we have had to implement.
